**The Southwest Florida Regional Coordination Study on Transportation  
Access for Veterans and Their Families  
Document Available For 45 Day Public Comment**

FORT MYERS, FL – (May 15, 2014) – The Southwest Florida Regional Planning Council (SWFRPC) announced today that the Southwest Florida Regional Coordination Study on Transportation Access for Veterans and Their Families is now available for a 45 day public comment period.

The Southwest Florida Regional Planning Council conducted a regional coordination study on transportation access for veterans and their families. The study is part of a collaborative effort among regional transportation providers and social service organizations to improve access to transportation options for veterans and their families. The project focused on the growing need for veteran services, and how to provide access to regional facilities that provide services for the veterans and other members of the public. Other factors driving the need for the study include: increasing demand for transit service created by new facilities, an increasing older population, and an expanding service area.
