

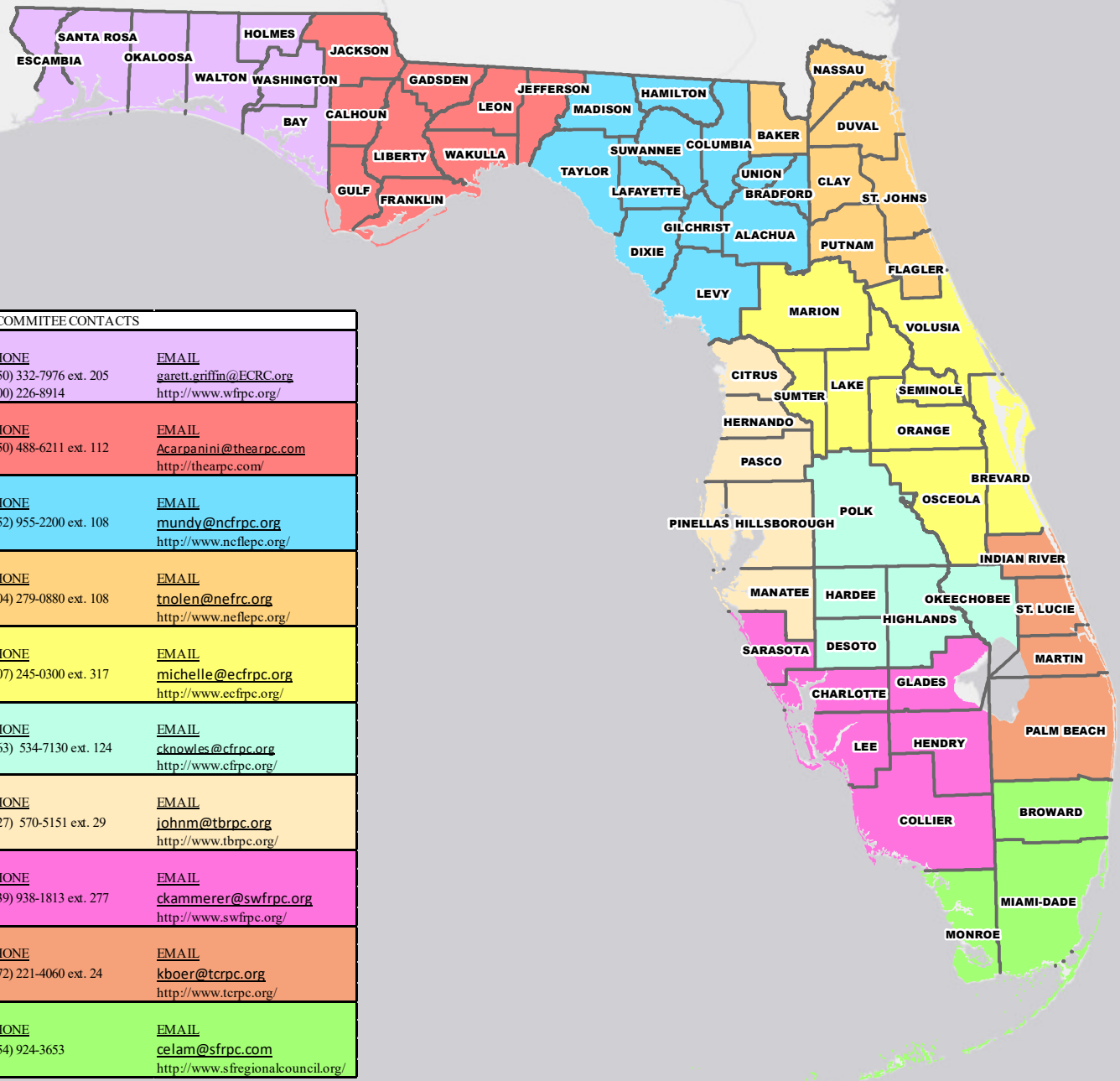

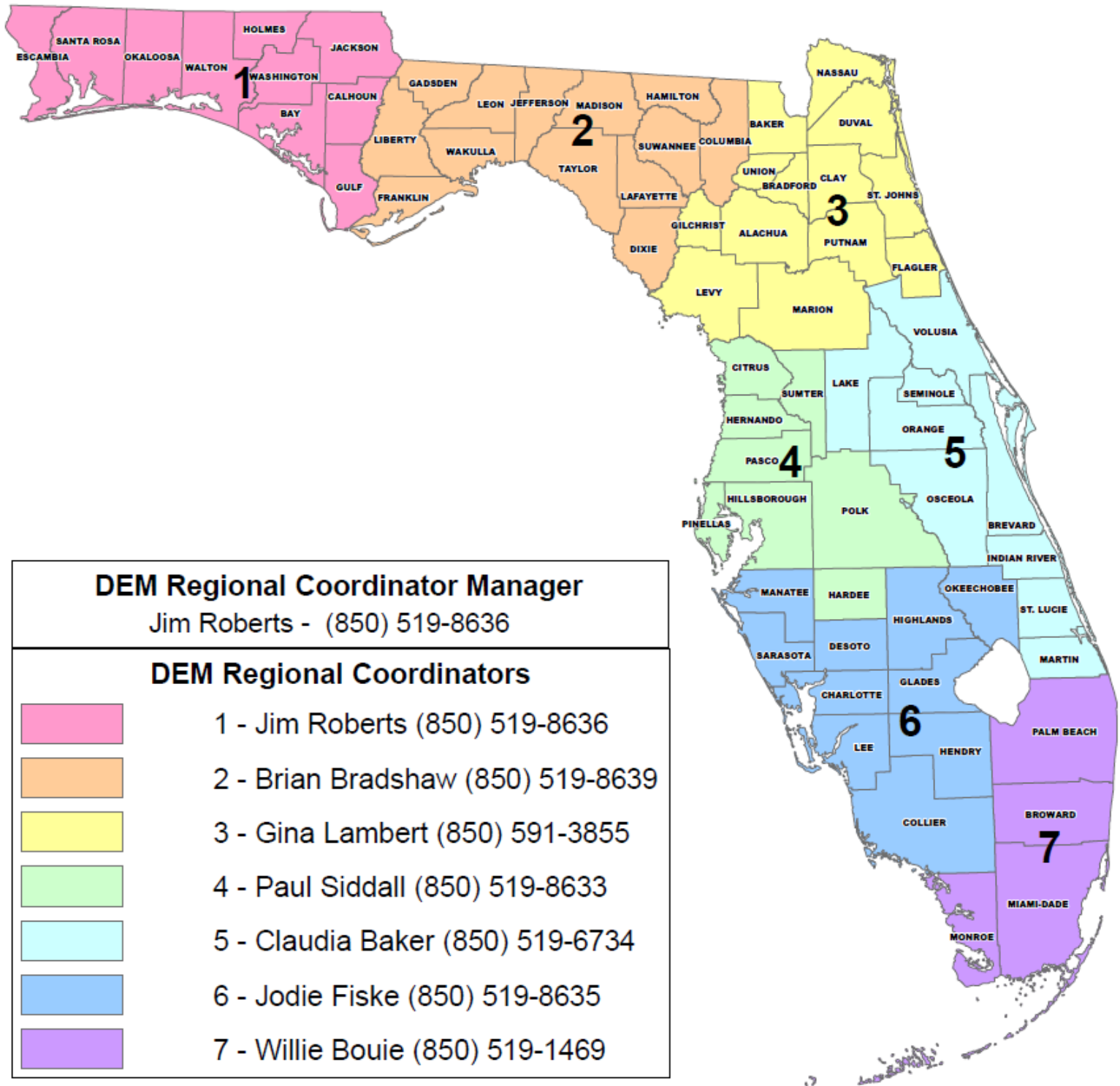

Invocation

Mr. Findley gave an invocation.

AGENDA ITEM #2
Pledge of Allegiance

Chairman Porter led the pledge of allegiance.

AGENDA ITEM #3
Call to Order & Introductions

Chairman Porter called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. Each member was asked to introduce themselves.

After the introductions, Mr. Massey and Mr. Fisher gave a presentation on LeeHealth's emergency response / disaster role, capabilities, and procedures. Afterwards, a discussion ensued about communication and coordination between first responders and hospitals.

AGENDA ITEM #4
Minutes of the August 22, 2019 Meeting

Chairman Porter entertained a motion to accept the draft LEPC meeting minutes of the August, 2019 meeting.

A motion was made by Chief Marshall to approve the minutes of the August 22, 2019 LEPC meeting as presented. The motion was seconded by Mr. Kerkering and passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Mr. Massey to approve the LEPC membership changes as presented. The motion was seconded by Chief Marshall and passed unanimously.

AGENDA ITEM #6 LEPC Meeting Schedule & Locations

Mr. Kammerer reviewed the upcoming schedule of SWF LEPC meetings and Statewide SERC meetings. The next SWF LEPC meeting is scheduled for February 20th at the Southwest Florida Regional Planning Council (1400 Colonial Blvd, Suite 1, Fort Myers, FL 33907). Mr. Kammerer asked for a volunteer to host the future 2020 meetings. Mr. Henderson volunteered to host the May meeting at the Cape Coral EOC. Mr. Tiefenthaler volunteered to host the August meeting at the North Port EOC.

AGENDA ITEM #7 2019 HazMat Symposium

Mr. Kammerer announced that the LEPC still has several spots open for the HazMat Symposium from January 21-24 in Dayton Beach. Registration is active and the LEPC currently has 7 attendees registered. Captain Wilkins is planning on sending 2 attendees and other members present expressed interest in attending. Chief Marshall explained that the Symposium is an incredible value in terms of the cost compared to the quality of the training.

AGENDA ITEM #8 Southwest Florida LEPC Training Subcommittee Report

Chief Marshall updated the Committee on two trainings that took place in Charlotte County (an NG/LPG course and a 406 Emergency course). Both Courses were well attended and received very positive feedback.

The LEPC has most of its FY 2020 HMEP funds committed to the HazMat Symposium, 406 Emergency Course, and SRQ Full-Scale HazMat Exercise. A Tanker Rollover Course requested by the North Collier Fire Department is the next training in line that falls into the FY 2020 budget. The HazMat Tech Course requested by the Sarasota County Fire Department will be pushed to FY 2021.

Chief Marshall presented the LEPC Training Request Procedures to the Committee and requested a motion.

A motion was made by Ms. Cerquera to approve the LEPC Training Request Procedures as presented. The motion was seconded by Captain Wilkins and passed unanimously.

Training requests are due to Mr. Kammerer by January 31. Requests will then be sent and ranked by the Training Subcommittee and brought to the LEPC at the February 20 meeting.

AGENDA ITEM #9 Tier II Reporting and E-Plan Update

Chief Marshall announced that the LEPC will be holding two Tier II / E-Plan Trainings for 302 Facilities on January 30 and February 20, both at the RPC. Training invites will be sent to the LEPC to distribute to their contacts. The reporting period begins on January 1 and ends on February 28. Mr. Zyvoloski asked if an E-Plan training could be held for responders / emergency management in Collier County. Chief Marshall volunteered to hold a course at no cost.

AGENDA ITEM #10 Florida SERC Training Task Force (TTF) Update

The last TTF Meeting was held in Sandestin on October 17. Chief Marshall gave a summary of the meeting. John (J.W.) Scott was hired by FDEM to handle all the State's HazMat team assessments for the upcoming year. Mr. Kammerer has already sent him the contact info for each team. Mr. Scott should be reaching out soon. The TTF drafted a letter of support for the NOVA maritime training. Four more SOGs/SOPs were completed (Gas Cylinders & Containers, Radiological, Safety & Health for HazMat, and Emergencies Involving Corrosives).

The last TTF conference call concerned the ongoing ethics concerns. A 2001 ruling determined that LEPC members do not need to fill out financial disclosure forms. FDEM has not come to a decision on the conflict of interest issue.

AGENDA ITEM #11 Florida State Emergency Response Commission (SERC) Meeting Update

The last SERC Meeting was held in Sandestin on October 18. Mr. Kammerer gave a summary of the meeting. The meeting was very brief, a tropical storm was set to hit the panhandle that day and FDEM wanted more time to prepare. The LEPC's 2019 Emergency Response Plan, quarterly membership updates, and Thomas Yatabe Award nominee were all voted on and accepted. Bill Miller, Deputy Special Operations Coordinator with the Fort Myers Fire Department, is SWF's Yatabe Award recipient. A presentation was given on PPE for gamma incidents.

Chief Marshall added that the East Central Florida LEPC announced that they received a \$78,000 PHMSA grant for pipeline response. LEPC staff created map overlaying fire department locations with all pipelines in the region. The grant was also used to purchase gas detection units. Chief Marshall and Mr. Kammmer can help in obtaining a similar grant.

AGENDA ITEM #15

Members' Comments

Captain Wilkins asked if the LEPC could fund a US National Grid with Field Operations class. Chief Marshall explained the written request would have to justify how this class ties into EHS chemicals and transportation. The written request would have to be submitted following the procedures voted on earlier in the meeting.

Captain Wilkins updated the LEPC on Sarasota County's experience in providing HazMat response for Hurricane Dorian. Sarasota and Pinellas Counties were the first two counties chosen to provide HazMat response to a Hurricane. The two counties provided 28 responders. The federal government provided a trailer of supplies for two teams.

Captain Wilkins also gave an update on the Full-Scale Exercise the LEPC is sponsoring, taking place at the Sarasota-Bradenton International Airport (SRQ) in February. The Exercise will simulate an EHS release on an airplane with a secondary incident of a suicide bomber. The Sarasota County Fire Department and LEPC have partnered with Bradenton County Fire Department, SRQ Emergency Management, and Sarasota Memorial Hospital among many others. Advanced Planning Consultants, who conducted the LEPC's Full-Scale at Cheney Brothers, has been hired to run the Exercise. Several LEPC members volunteered to act as

evaluators and controllers for the Exercise.

Chief Marshall asked for advice in purchasing a new decon trailer.

RECAP OF THE JANUARY 22, 2020 STATE EMERGENCY RESPONSE COMMISSION (SERC) MEETING



The January 22, 2020 SERC meeting was held at the Plaza Resort and Spa in Daytona Beach. The Recap presented below was enhanced by discussions/dialogues which ensued at the January 21 meetings of SERC's Training Task Force and the LEPC Staff & Chairs. The SERC meeting was chaired by Mr. Kevin Guthrie, FDEM Deputy Director/SERT Chief. The meeting was called to order at 10:30 a.m. and proceeded with the Pledge of Allegiance and a roll call of SERC members.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The October 19, 2019 SERC meeting minutes were approved unanimously upon voice vote.

NEW BUSINESS

- 1. LOCAL EMERGENCY PLANNING COMMITTEES (LEPCs) APPOINTMENTS-** The LEPC membership modifications being requested by the LEPCs are included in the SERC packet. SERC unanimously approved all proposed membership modifications upon voice vote. SWF had the following updates, approved by the SWF LEPC at the December meeting:

- 2. THE 2020 THOMAS YATABE SERC AWARD CEREMONY-** Each LEPC presented their nominee for the Yatabe Awards. The SWF LEPC selected Mr. Bill Miller, Engineer / Deputy Special Operations Coordinator, Fort Myers Fire Department, for the award due to his excellent service to the regional HazMat community. Mr. Bruce Porter introduced Mr. Miller and Mr. Guthrie presented him with the award.

3. **ESF-10 GIS PORTAL AND SURVEY123 APPLICATION-** Mr. Nick Roff, FDEP, gave a presentation on the application of the ESF-10 GIS portal and Survey123 during a disaster situation.

REPORTS

1. **SERC TRAINING TASK FORCE (TTF) REPORT-** Mr. Guthrie reported on the TTF meeting. He requested that presentations on HazMat incidents be brought to future TTF meetings. An impromptu presentation was given at an incident in Ocala. The TTF was given a final ruling on the ongoing conflict of interest issues. FDEM lawyer, Mr. Erik Sayler, requested that any TTF / LEPC member with a potential conflict of interest reach out to the Florida Commission on Ethics to receive an informal ruling.
2. **HAZARDS ANALYSIS WORKING GROUP (HAWG) REPORT-** Mr. Robert Dietrich explained he is working to improve the HA program and make everything more user friendly.
3. **UPDATE ON LEPC ACTIVITIES-** LEPC Chair Richard Delp reported on the LEPC meeting. Each district gave an update on their trainings and exercises in the last quarter during the meeting. The 2020 ERG books are expected to arrive in April or May. FDEM received extra HMEP funding that must be spent by June 1. SWF LEPC requested funding for a North Collier HazMat Tech Course.
4. **FINANCIAL STATUS REPORT-** Mr. Dietrich indicated that there is no change in the financial status. The following reports were included as part of the Agenda materials:
 - Monthly RMP & EPCRA program revenue allocations; and
 - Breakdown of General Appropriations and Expenditures by Category for the Hazardous Materials Planning and the Risk Management Planning Programs.
5. **HAZARDOUS MATERIALS INCIDENTS REPORT-** As informational, Mr. Dietrich indicated that detailed listings of Section 304 investigations, fixed facility and transportation-related hazardous materials incidents were prepared and included with the Agenda materials to describe incidents occurring between the period of September 1, 2019 – November 30, 2019. Such Reports included documentation of these incidents and portrayed the number of persons evacuated, injured or deceased down to LEPC District and ultimately County levels. These are all incidents reported to the State Watch Office and are broken down into different categories.
6. **STAFF ACTIVITIES REPORT BY SECTION-** Mr. Dietrich indicated that various graphics were provided within the SERC Agenda materials to depict various staff functions and initiatives. Information was provided in the Agenda materials to portray:

- Breakdown of statewide Hazardous Materials Incident Reports by LEPC District and type;
- Annual enumeration of Hazardous Materials incidents;
- Monthly enumeration of Hazardous Materials Incident;
- Quantification of E-Plan Filings for Year 2018 by LEPC District
- Monthly quantification of Technical Assistance calls received; and
- Annual enumeration of Chemical Data in E-Plan since 2012 in terms of the number of statewide facilities and number of chemicals.

OTHER BUSINESS

- 1. THE 2020 HAZMAT SYMPSOIIUM-** Chief Jonathan Lamb gave an update on the progress of the 2020 HazMat Symposium. They year, they had a record 619 people registered, 436 being students. He stressed that this would not be possible without the support from SERC and the hard work of the LEPCs.
- 2. HAZMAT TEAM ASSESSMENT, DEPLOYMENTS, EXERCISE, AND TRAINING-** Mr. Scott Chappell explained that Mr. J.W. Scott has completed roughly 2/3 of the HazMat Team Assessments across the State.

COMMENTS

There were no additional comments.

ADJOURNMENT

Upon identification of no more issues to be brought before the SERC, Mr. Guthrie adjourned the meeting and advised that the next SERC meeting will be held April 17, 2020 in St. Augustine.
