



AGENDA ITEM #1-3
Call to Order & Introductions

Chairman Porter called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m. The pledge of allegiance was said, and roll call was conducted.

AGENDA ITEM #4
Minutes of the May 27, 2021, Meeting

Chairman Porter entertained a motion to accept the draft LEPC meeting minutes of the May 27, 2021, meeting.

A motion was made by Chief Matt Marshall to approve the minutes of the May 27, 2021, LEPC meeting as presented. The motion was seconded by Ms. Brenda Barnes and passed unanimously.

AGENDA ITEM #5
LEPC Membership

There were no proposed LEPC membership changes this quarter.

AGENDA ITEM #6
Thomas Yatabe Award Nominations

Ms. Kubasik explained that it is that time of year again for each LEPC to nominate deserving individuals, agencies, or organizations for the Thomas Yatabe Award of distinction. She stressed that the LEPC did not submit any nominations last year, so it is important that this year we do, since there is so many deserving of the award. The award signifies “outstanding contribution made in the implementation and support of the Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act through achievement(s), accomplishment(s) or superior participation in hazardous material planning or response.” Ms. Kubasik added that she will send out another email with the nomination forms and procedures for nominations and requests all forms be returned by the September 9th deadline.

AGENDA ITEM #7
SERC Meeting Updates

Ms. Kubasik explained that the last SERC meeting was May 26th and the LEPC received an update at the May 27th meeting. There was a meeting on August 10th of the LEPC Chairs/Coordinators that was conducted virtually. At the meeting there was an update given for the 2020 Hazmat Symposium, and despite the recent surge in COVID cases, the plans for the Symposium are still moving forward at this time. Contingency plans have already been determined, including an unspecified deadline to determine whether to proceed with the in-person training event.

Lodging contracts have been signed and executed with the Plaza Resort& Spa and the Hard Rock Hotel in Daytona Beach. The Hazardous Materials Teams Competition will, once again, be held at the Volusia County Training Grounds simultaneous with the Symposium event.

The LEPCs have been authorized to continue to hold virtual quarterly meetings until further notice due to the recent surge in COVID cases across the state. The next LEPC Chair/Coordinator and SERC meeting will be held in Sarasota October 21-22, 2021.

Ms. Kubasik went on to discuss the SERC financial situation regarding the FY21-22 LEPC Staff Services Contract/ Grant that was reduced by \$10,000. Several previously required tasks were eliminated to offset the reduction of these grant funds. However, FDEM is looking to reinstate those funds starting in FY22-23.

Chair Bruce Porter added that at the LEPC Chair/Coordinator meeting it was noted that Ms. Kubasik is doing a good job adjusting in the Coordinator Position and Ms. Kubasik credited Mr. John Meyer of the Tampa Bay LEPC, Ms. Kate Boer of the Treasure Coast LEPC, FDEM staff and Chief Mat Marshal the SWF LEPC Training Chair for all of their help and guidance.

AGENDA ITEM #9 LEPC HazMat Exercise 2021-2022

Chief Marshall explained that this morning the first planning meeting was held for the FY21-22 HazMat Exercise. The LEPC will provide funds for a contractor and do the after-action report. The request for funds is no more than \$10,000.

A motion was made by Jason Wilkins to authorize up to \$10,000 to bring in a contractor to assist with the exercise. The motion was seconded by Chair Bruce Porter and passed unanimously.

Southwest Florida LEPC Training Subcommittee Report

Chief Marshall explained that there are two courses that were approved and will be completed by October 1st. There is a HazMat Safety Course that will be in September conducted by a group out of Louisiana, this group has taught several classes in the area a few years back. This course will be 3 days long at 3 different locations. There will also be a Propane Course in September that will be 6 days long, 3 days in Cape Coral because they are splitting the cost and 3 days in other locations possibly North Collier, Sarasota, and Charlotte County. This course will be an 8-hour hands on course.
