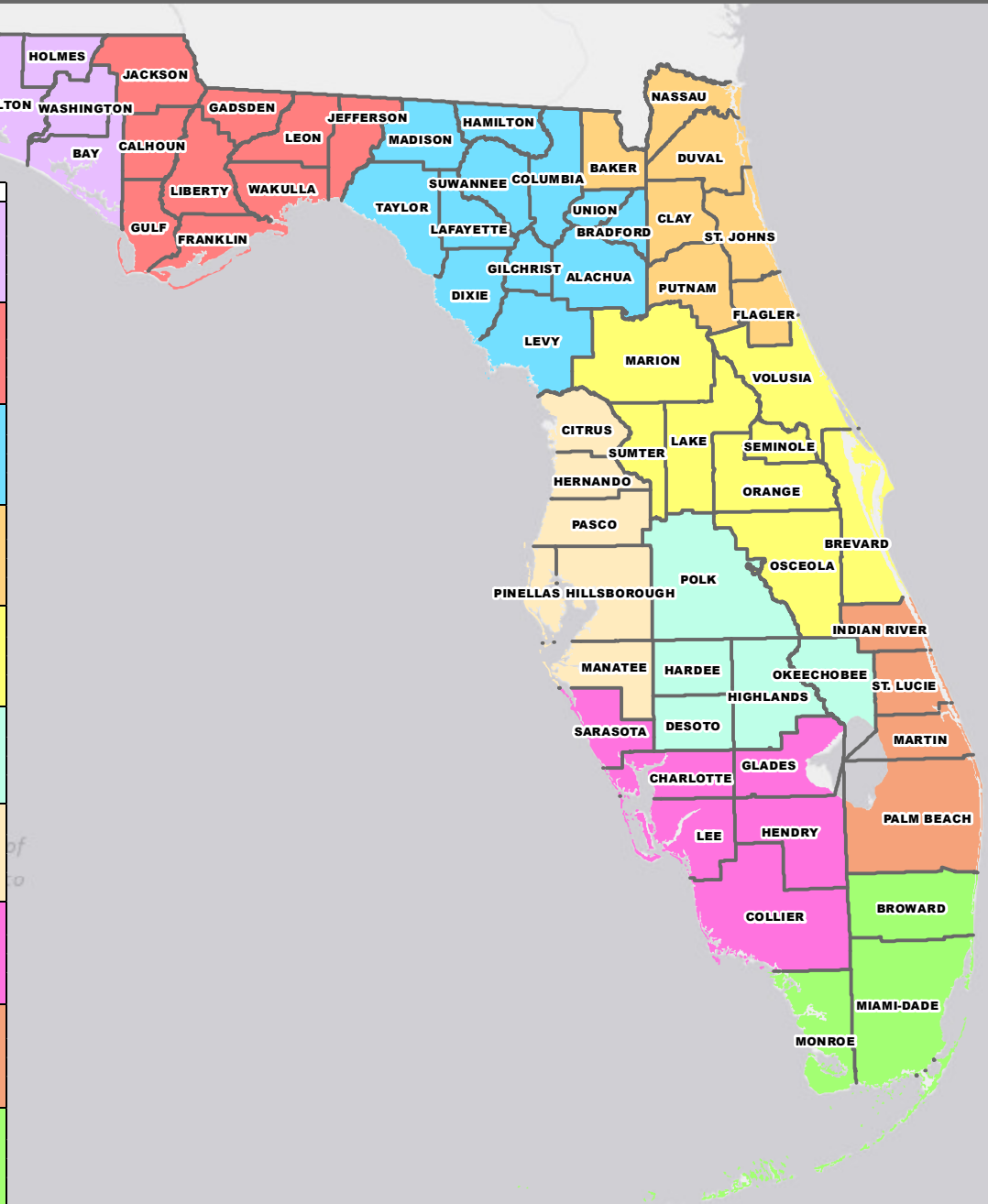

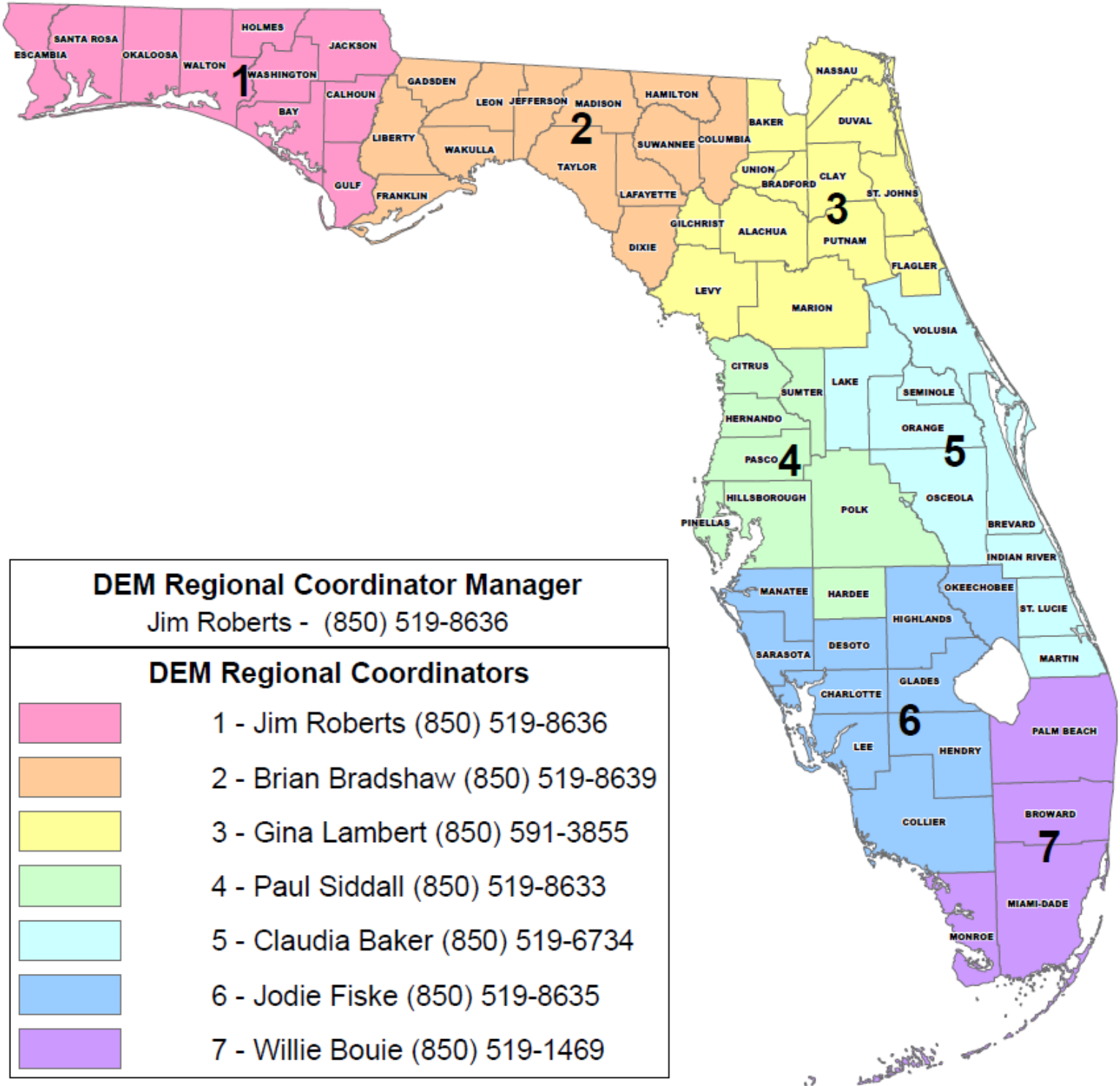

**AGENDA ITEM #1-3
Call to Order & Introductions**

Chief Mike Seneca gave an invocation and immediately following, Chairman Porter called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. and the pledge of allegiance was said.

**AGENDA ITEM #4
Minutes of the August 26, 2021 Meeting**

Chairman Porter entertained a motion to accept the draft LEPC meeting minutes of the August 26, 2021 meeting.

A motion was made by Scott Davis to approve the minutes of the August 26, 2021 LEPC meeting as presented. The motion was seconded by Chief Matt Marshall and passed unanimously.

**AGENDA ITEM #5
LEPC Membership**

There was one nomination form submitted for LEPC membership.

- Wes Allen, Facility Owners and Operators (Florida Gas Transmission Company)
Wes will be taking the place of Michael Laycock of Florida Gas Transmission Company who retired earlier this year.

A motion was made by Chief Matt Marshall to approve the LEPC membership of Wes Allen. The motion was seconded by Chief Mike Seneca and passed unanimously.

**AGENDA ITEM #6
Presentation: Battery Energy Storage Systems (BESS)**

Mr. Jeff Moyer of Florida Power & Light Company gave a presentation with PowerPoint on Battery Energy Storage Systems. He began his presentation discussing a 2019 explosion at an Arizona Public Service facility where utility-size lithium batteries used in the storage and distribution of solar energy were housed. This explosion caused the hospitalization of eight firefighters from two separate agencies.

Mr. Moyer continued on to share the location of FPL's current operational BESS and their plans for the location of new BESS. He then shared the First Responder Orientation for non-walk-in enclosures and used the Babcock Ranch Energy Storage Center as a visual example. He covered:

- Lithium-ion Battery Energy Storage Systems (BESS)
- BESS Site Equipment Overview and Hazards
- Fire Detection and Incipient Stage Suppression
- Emergency Responder: Hazards and Precautions
- Site Aerial and Site Map with Gate Access and Warning Signs
- Emergency Response: Key Considerations
- Emergency and Site Contact Information

Ms. Kubasik requested that anyone who has a meeting location available for our LEPC meeting days, with technology capabilities to please let her know. Chief Seneca offered the Charlotte County EOC for the February meeting. Other locations TBD.

AGENDA ITEM #8 SERC Meeting Recap

Ms. Kubasik attended the October SERC meeting as well as the Training Task Force meeting and LEPC Coordinator meeting in Sarasota. She reminded everyone that the HazMat Symposium is on for January 18-21, 2022 and the deadline for registration is December 10, 2021. She informed everyone that this HazMat symposium has had over 80 white papers submitted and is expected to be one of the biggest yet. The LEPC requests that those who would like to attend purchase their HazMat Symposium registration ticket and forward their confirmation of purchase to Ms. Kubasik, she will then book the hotel stay and following proof of attendance at the Symposium, registrants will be sent a reimbursement check for the symposium registration fee.

AGENDA ITEM #9 LEPC HazMat Exercise 2021-2022

Chief Marshall explained that there will be a HazMat Exercise taking place in March 2022 and there is already a committee in place, a contractor will be hired, and the exercise will consist of the deployment of HazMat teams from home base to deployment. With events that have happened in recent years, FDEM now wants to deploy teams before a hurricane hits so that *if* the hurricane hits where it is predicted to, the teams are already there and in place to help and take action for the aftermath. This HazMat exercise will be a redeployment model and take place for 3 days with 2 teams each day for 12 hours. They will be called in at 8am for deployment and respond for 12 hour duration. The LEPC would like to bring in locals to evaluate and DEP to work together and watch the exercise.

AGENDA ITEM #10 Southwest Florida LEPC Training Subcommittee Report

Chief Marshall explained that the Subcommittee will be soliciting for members. Chief Seneca volunteered to join the Subcommittee. The members now consist of Chief Marshall, Teresa Zilko, Scott Davis, Rhonda Holtzclaw and Chief Seneca.

Chief Marshall went on to discuss the procedure for classes. He stated the responders submit

requests for trainings for next year. Currently for the 21-22 year there are 2 HazMat tech classes, one in Charlotte County and another in North Collier County. He went on to explain how to get proposals for vendors and added that first responders can also put in for conferences throughout the U.S. that they may want to attend as long as the request is submitted prior for approval.

Chief Marshall let the LEPC members know that \$20,000 has been set aside for the HazMat Symposium and that is the amount every year that is set aside. The whole \$20,000 has never been spent so the left-over money can be used for a last-minute training. He reminded everyone again that December 10, 2021 is the deadline for registration for the symposium.

A motion was made by Scott Davis for the approval of the procedures. The motion was seconded by Teresa Zilko and passed unanimously.

AGENDA ITEM #11

Tier II Reporting and E-Plan Update

Chief Marshall stated that an email blast will be sent out starting in January 2022 for the 2021 reporting year. New information on E-Plan will be sent out for responders but currently there are no new federal updates.

Chief Marshall added that immediately after the February LEPC meeting there will be an EPCRA/E-plan, Tier II Reporting presentation.

Chief Marshall shared brief information on BUXUS, a platform that was presented on at the October SERC meeting and was endorsed by the LEPC committee. He stated that he will give a

brief presentation on this National Pipeline Mapping System at the next meeting.

Members' Comments

Chief Matt Marshall shared that there is a Tag Grant that typically opens up in January through March. The grant is for National Gas and Underground pipeline use. Chief Marshall added that he put in for \$100,000 and ended up being awarded \$50,000 and purchased new gas monitors for the department. This is a no match grant and other departments within the region have also been awarded money from the grant, so he suggested that others apply for the funding.

Chief Marshall also shared that the City of Cape Coral is getting a new HazMat station, they also have \$1.2 million to build a new HazMat truck and \$6 million for a new training facility.
