





AGENDA ITEM #1-3 Call to Order & Introductions

There was no member who wished to give an invocation. In the absence of the chair, Bruce Porter, Charity Franks, the coordinator called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. Roll call was taken. The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

AGENDA ITEM #4

Minutes of the August 24, 2023 Meeting

Substitute Chair, Charity Franks, entertained a motion to accept the draft LEPC meeting minutes of the August 24, 2023 meeting.

A motion was made by Dan Sieber to approve the minutes of the August 24, 2023 LEPC meeting as presented. The motion was seconded by Tod Kerkering and passed unanimously.

AGENDA ITEM #5 LEPC Membership

The position of Vice Chair is still open for any member wishing to be nominated. No nominations were officially proposed, however Chief Lawrence Factor of Glades County Fire/EMS expressed interest in joining the LEPC

AGENDA ITEM #6 Presentation

Dan Nedvidek from Terracon Inc. gave a presentation on Environmental Challenges and Brownfields, providing insightful explanations of the Brownfields redevelopment process and sharing anecdotes about site cleanups.

AGENDA ITEM #8 SERC Meeting Recap

The staff discussed the subjects brought up at the October SERC Meeting including, The Electric Vehicle Lithium-Ion Battery Symposium, The PFAS firefighting foam disposal initiative, and The Offshore Hazmat Pilot program. The major discussion points during the SERC meetings were the updates presented by the HA working group, the EV Battery Presentation from an On Scene Coordinator with the Federal EPA, the initiative to get FDEM to update the State Watch Office reporting criteria to include Lithium-Ion Battery related emergency response so that data can be collected by the SERC, Florida Fire Marshals office, and all other interested parties, and the Hazmat Symposium.

Ms. Franks announced that the LEPC is reimbursing attendees for registration fees for the hazmat symposium after attendance and is reserving hotel rooms for registrants who provide invoices to the SWFRPC.

AGENDA ITEM #9 Southwest Florida LEPC Training Subcommittee Report

Chief Marshall was unable to attend the LEPC Meeting. Ms. Franks shared an announcement from FDEM that NSU offers HAZWOPER training including, Train-the-Trainer. Also, that NSU offers courses in English and Spanish, and in-person or online. No cost as NSU receives PHMSA funding.

AGENDA ITEM #10 Tier II Reporting and E-Plan Update

Ms. Franks announced that the site visits for the quarter were completed, and that LEPC staff were preparing to submit the files to FDEM.

AGENDA ITEM #11 Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM) Trainings and Events

Ms. Franks explained that on the State's website http://trac.floridadisaster.org/trac/training calendar.aspx there is the calendar of events and trainings that are available. The events are also listed in the meeting packet. Ms. Franks also shared that the Director of the Florida Division of State Fire Marshal JoAnne Rice indicated that they are considering making the Electric Vehicle Lithium-Ion Battery Symposium an annual event.

AGENDA ITEM #12 Hazardous Material Incidents in Southwest Florida

Ms. Franks explained that on the State's website https://apps.floridadisaster.org/swo/ArchiveNonAdmin.aspx there is a running list of hazardous materials incidents by county. The incidents are also listed in the meeting packet.

AGENDA ITEM #13 Topics for Future Meeting

Ms. Franks opened the floor for any future meeting topics, she went over the guidelines for presentations. Anyone with a topic should send it to Ms. Franks for coordination. Ms. Franks also shared a suggested topic from Margaret Wuerstle from the Southwest Florida Regional Planning Council. The topic was a project of inventorying or surveying hotels in Southwest Florida to see how many have generators, since elderly or disabled evacuees from natural disasters, who rely on electricity for their medical devices and temperature regulation might be in danger if they evacuate to a hotel unequipped for emergencies.

AGENDA ITEM #14 Members Comments

Shane Styza from Charlotte County Fire/EMS asked for Ms. Franks to send out an email to LEPC members with instructions for seeking reimbursements and hotel reservations for the Hazmat Symposium.

Tim Dorsey and Jason Wilkins from Sarasota County Fire Department asked about the process for submitting training requests. Ms. Franks provided a basic procedure for submitting training requests and asked them to contact her directly regarding a course they were interested in getting approved.

AGENDA ITEM #15 Public Comments

Chief Lawrence Factor of Glades County shared an account of an incident where a train derailment caused a spill of molasses in his region. Although the spill was not dangerous, Chief Factor wanted to know what resources were available to Emergency Management personnel other than his contacts in the EPA. Ms. Franks informed him that she would check with her resources in the SERC and other coordinators and would seek out a directory of resources for him.

SERC LEPC Membership Categories:

Local Emergency Planning Committees (LEPCs) must have representatives from the following occupational categories, as required in Section 301(c) of the Emergency Planning and Community Right-To-Know Act (EPCRA):

- 1. elected state/local officials;
- 2. law enforcement;
- 3. emergency management (civil defense in EPCRA);
- 4. firefighting;
- 5. first aid;
- 6. health;
- 7. local environmental;
- 8. hospital;
- 9. transportation personnel;
- 10. broadcast/print media;
- 11. community groups;
- 12. facility owners/operators subject to EPCRA;
- 13. interested citizens;
- 14. non-elected local officials;
- 15. water management district representative;
- 16. local option.

There should be a continued good faith effort on behalf of the LEPC chairperson to ensure that all of the occupational categories are represented on the LEPC.

Note: The following SERC categories are not EPCRA LEPC Membership Categories (§ 301(c)):

- First Aid
- Interested Citizen
- Non-elected Official
- Water Management District
- Local Option
- Local Environmental

Pursuant to 42 USC §11001(c), Establishment of local emergency planning committees, each local emergency planning committee "shall include, at a minimum, representatives from each of the following groups or organizations: elected State and local officials; law enforcement, civil defense, firefighting, first aid, health, local environmental, hospital, and transportation personnel; broadcast and print media; community groups; and owners and operators of facilities subject to the requirements of this subchapter."
